Each semester includes a minimum of 75 teaching days (not counting Saturdays) and 7 examination days. The regular summer session includes a minimum of 40 teaching and examination days.

One semester hour of credit is earned by (1) one recitation period of 60 minutes each week for a semester; (2) two laboratory periods of 10 minutes each week for a semester; (3) two recitation periods or four laboratory periods each week for the summer session.

The full load per student is 16 or 18 credit hours each semester, and 14 or 8 credit hours each summer session. The undergraduate schools require a minimum of 120 academic hours for graduation.
